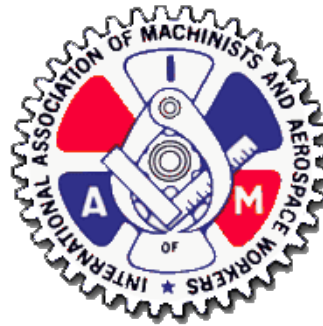

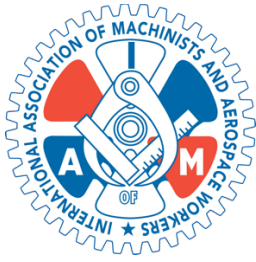
This one-time \$1,500 scholarship is awarded each year to a deserving high school senior who is the legal child or step-child of any member in good standing of Chapter 463 of the International Association of the Machinists and Aerospace Workers Union.

A Scholarship Selection Committee arranged by the Scholarship Committee Chairperson from "Hercules" Chapter 463, screens the applications and makes a recommendation to the Lodge's Executive Board. The winner will be notified in writing or by phone by the Scholarship Committee Chairperson and informed when the scholarship presentation will be made. The scholarship is typically awarded to the recipient at the June general membership meeting. The scholarship check will be made out to the applicant and may be used .

The packet should be sealed, your name written on the front, and returned to the Scholarship Committee Chairperson. Applications must be turned in no later than May 31 of the current year.
